Subject: ELV: Amended report of the 7th Adaption: Amendments concern exemption 8(f)

Dear Madam / Sir,

We would like to inform you that an amended version of the report: "7th Adaption to Scientific and Technical Progress of Exemptions 8(e), 8(f), 8(g), 8(h), 8(j) and 10(d) of Annex II to Directive 2000/53/EC (ELV)" was published today.

Amendments have been made with regards to exemption 8(f): The transition period and the reference to the type approval of vehicles were neglected in the exemption wording recommended in the previous report (dated 14/01/2015) and therefore had to be added to give industry a transition period to respond to the new, restricted exemption scope. In agreement with the stakeholders, the following new wording and transition period is now proposed for exemption 8(f):

i) Lead in compliant pin connector systems for vehicles type-approved before 1 January 2017 and spare parts for these vehicles.

ii) Lead in compliant pin connector systems other than the mating area of vehicle harness connectors for vehicles type-approved after 31 December 2016

The transition period until end of December 2016 should leave sufficient time for industry to adapt to the new exemption scope without postponing the restriction of avoidable lead use more than necessary.

Amendments of the report concern section 5.3.2 Conclusions and 5.4 Recommendation.
