

Contribution scheme for the Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles section 2023

Membership of the Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles section consists of four modules, namely:

1. Membership section Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles
2. Subscription to homologation service
3. Individual support
4. In-house workshop

Membership of the Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles section (module 1) is mandatory in order to be able to purchase modules 2 and/or 3 and/or 4.

Contribution

The membership fee for the Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles section is based on a number of principles, namely:

1. that the amount of contribution must be transparent and predictable for the individual members;
2. whereas, on one hand, account should be taken of the development of car sales, but at the same time large annual fluctuations in the amount should be avoided;
3. that the car sales are the basis for the calculation of the membership;
4. that a distinction is made between a basic membership and a subscription to additional services such as a homologation information service;
5. that a distinction is made in the amounts between small, economical city cars, middle class cars, luxury cars and delivery vans.

The above principles are part of a system in which the contribution of a member of the Passenger Cars and Light Commercial Vehicles section is based on the average of car sales in the previous three years. Companies that sell less than 500 vehicles on average pay a base amount of € 5,520 for membership in the section, as do companies that sell more than 500 vehicles but whose membership fee would be less than € 5,520.

Homologation

A subscription to the RAI homologation service costs € 8,000 per brand. Although it is not compulsory to purchase this service, it is exclusively available to RAI members. Membership of the RAI Association is therefore a requirement for using this service.

Individual services

At your request, we have also developed the possibility to receive additional support from RAI Association policy experts. We would appoint a special account manager to act as your contact person and to direct your questions to the relevant experts within RAI Association. The account manager coordinates all work done for you. We can reserve 10 hours per month or 20 hours per month for this additional service. The service is purchased for a year. The hourly rate for a subscription of 10 hours per month is € 150 and for a subscription of 20 hours per month € 120. Any additional hours will be charged in addition at the applicable regular subscription rate.

In-house workshops

Finally, it is possible to organize a workshop on location with a specific theme. The costs of an in-house workshop are € 3,300. These costs do not include the costs of any room hire, catering and the costs of any external speakers to be hired.
