The Automotive Industry



In 2022 the Global Automotive industry has faced a lot of challenges. Due to global instability and crises, resulting in inflation, personnel shortage, shortage of material and a disruption in the supply chain, combined with the impact upon decarbonization and digitization. This situation is likely to continue in 2023.

Green and Smart Transport Delta Program



- The **Hydrogen** projects evolve around cross-sectional mobility applications for the automotive, marine, and non-road mobile machinery sectors. The three hydrogen technologies: hydrogen combustion engines, hydrogen fuel cells, and a next-generation hydrogen refueling infrastructure technology are the pillars of this project.
- The **Electrification** goal is to develop the battery-ecosystem in the Netherlands. By strengthening the production of batteries, the Netherlands is able to improve their competitiveness internationally, as well as taking an important step closer to sustainable mobility.
- The **DITM**: (The Digital Infrastructure for Future Proof Mobility) is a consortium devoted to the question of how to develop Cooperative, Connected and Mobility Systems (CCAM) that can work in a safe, effective, cyber-secure, scalable and brand-independent way.

Battery Competence Cluster - NL



The Battery Competence Cluster - NL is the program where companies, knowledge institutions, and organizations join forces to build knowledge and competencies in the field of battery technology. The Dutch battery, transport, and shipping industries all meet here.

The 3 Pillars:

- New battery cells and manufacturing processes
- Battery systems for:
 - Heavy duty transport
 - Energy storage
- Recycling & Second-use

The goal of the Internationalization program is innovation and trade promotion. RAI Automotive Industry NL is committed to supporting its members internationally. This includes building and maintaining relationships and promoting innovation and trade relations with a special focus on Germany, France and the United States. 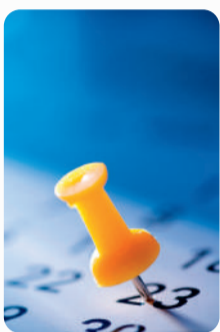
